### HOSTEL POLICY, RULES, AND REGULATIONS FOR HOSTELLERS

#### INTRODUCTION

JSSATE offers Hostel facilities for students with the primary objective of infusing self-confidence and self-discipline in providing a safe and homely environment. Hostel accommodation, separately for men and women, will be provided by the institute solely based on availability. The guiding principle towards the formulation of the Hostel Policy, Rules & Regulations for Hostellers is to ensure a secure and comfortable environment which is conducive to learning, and all hostellers are required to strictly abide by the same.

## **HOSTEL AUTHORITIES**

Principal, Warden, and Resident Manager, where the Resident Manager would reside in the hostel premises. They would be responsible for the day-to-day operations and administration of all hostel activities. Responsibilities, roles, and the powers of each of these authorities will be notified to the hostellers, as applicable.

### HOSTEL ADMISSION

- Students seeking admission to the hostels must apply for the same at the time of Admission to the institute.
- The student must pay the Hostel Fee and Mess Fee as prescribed by the institute (charged annually), including a refundable Hostel Deposit. At the time of the hostel room allocation, the students should produce the Hostel Fee and Mess Fee receipts to the concerned hostel authority.
- The hostel deposit will be utilized for any penalties/recovery costs related to damages/breakages caused by the student to the property/facilities of the hostel.
- Students are provided with an accidental insurance policy, which shall be utilized to students' benefits during any accidents.
- At the time of admission to the hostel, a declaration agreeing to abide by the Hostel Policy, Rules and & Regulations as may be notified from time to time shall be signed by the student.
- Hostel allocation will be prioritized based on the distance of the student's home town.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. Students have to pay the hostel & mess fee within 15 days from the commencement of the classes.
- 2. Students admitted to hostel have to join the mess compulsorily.
- 3. Students should occupy their allotted rooms with written permission from the hostel warden.
- 4. In general, the inmates are expected to be back in the hostel by 7.30 P.M. and also shall not leave the hostel premises after 9.30 P.M.

- 5. Non-Veg, Smoking and Alcohol are strictly prohibited in and around the hostel area.
- 6. Students are requested to consume food in the mess hall only and outside eatables are not allowed.
- 7. Students must not allow non-hostelites to the hostel campus.
- 8. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Any indiscipline in this regard will entail a minimum punishment of expulsion from the hostel immediately. In addition, the student is also subject to expulsion from the college & students involved in anti-social activities will be expelled from the hostel.
- 9. Students are not allowed to change their rooms without the permission of the warden/resident warden.
- 10. In case of health issues, contact the resident manager.
- 11. Students should give the list of articles, furniture, etc. in their respective rooms belonging to the college and are wholly responsible for the same, any damage should be intimated immediately or else the entire cost will be recovered from the inmates, the cost of repairs, if any will be charged to the inmates of the particular room.
- 12. Watching TV and playing games is not prohibited after 10.00 P.M.
- 13. Students are expected to maintain their rooms clean and tidy.
- 14. Students who are detained in their semester exams are not eligible to continue in the hostel.
- 15. Students have to inform the resident warden before leaving the hostel in order to go to their hometown.
- 16. If a student wishes to leave the hostel before the end of the academic year, he has to pay the hostel fee for the full academic year.
- 17. Caution deposit paid at the time of joining will not be adjusted with any of the other fee/bills. It will be refunded only after vacating the hostel.
- 18. For the Girls' hostel, a mess charge at a rate of Rs.2600/- per month is collected for 10 months initially. In case of extensions in the academic year, mess charges have to be paid for the additional month.
- 19. Hostel room rent is charged for the entire academic year.
